

We have so enjoyed the start to all our programmes this year, and meeting all our amazing new participants coming to learn and make connections with animals. One cool story from the term so far has been seeing one participant who started out not talking much, finding it hard to make eye contact, unable make choices or share his thoughts. This young boy made a friendship with one of our little miniature horses Maxi, and started off cuddling, brushing and even painting him. These calming sensory activities allowed him to relax and become open to more learning, and over the weeks we were able to introduce leading, obstacle courses, adventures, and more and more skills with the horses. It is so amazing to see how this young boy is now so skilled, so much more confident and expressive, and has such joy! He shows others how to be a leader, how to care for the horses, how to show empathy. He makes his own decisions, has wonderful problem-solving skills, and is much more open to teamwork.
